



PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

Weber-Morgan Health Department Weber and Morgan Counties, Utah

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2020, Utah Governor Gary R. Herbert issued an Executive Order moving the State COVID-19 Public Health Risk Status from Red (High Risk) to Orange (Moderate Risk), and

WHEREAS, community members, businesses, and government entities have all worked together to successfully slow the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, in order to build upon that success and reduce the public health risk even further, those collective efforts must continue; and

WHEREAS, as community transmission of COVID-19 remains, it is imperative for individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19, are symptomatic, or have been identified as a direct contact to self-isolate and quarantine;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WEBER-MORGAN HEALTH OFFICER BRIAN BENNION ISSUES THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE:

SECTION I. ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE.

1. An individual who tests positive with COVID-19, is presenting symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or has been identified as a direct contact shall follow the direction of public health officials, including any direction to self-isolate and quarantine.
2. Failure to do so may result in the issuance of a verbal or written order of restriction pursuant to Utah Code § 26-6b-1 *et al.*

SECTION II. INDIVIDUALS AND BUSINESSES

1. All Weber and Morgan County residents should familiarize themselves with and adhere to the Phased Guidelines for the General Public and Businesses to Maximize Public Health and Economic Reactivation ordered by Governor Herbert on April 29, 2020.
