



List of Accepted Identifications Required To Obtain Certified Documents

Government-issued identification is required for the purchase of a Utah birth or death certificate. Mailed requests must include an enlarged and easily identifiable photocopy of the back and front of your I.D. If no identification is enclosed, your application will be returned. All identification **MUST** be current.

PRIMARY

At least 1 of the following:

- ✓ School, University or College I.D.
- ✓ U.S. Military Identification Card
- ✓ Tribal Identification Card
- ✓ Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card
- ✓ U.S. Passport

- ✓ U.S. Certification of Naturalization
- ✓ Certificate of U.S. Citizenship
- ✓ U.S. Citizenship I.D. Card
- ✓ Matricula Consular Card
- ✓ Concealed Fire Arm Permit
- ✓ Mexican Voter Registration Card

SECONDARY

Or at least 2 of the following:

- ✓ Work Identification/ W-2 or Paycheck
- ✓ Voter Registration Card
- ✓ U.S. Military Separation/ DD-214
- ✓ Motor Vehicle Registration/Title
- ✓ Probation Documents
- ✓ Marriage License
- ✓ Divorce Decree
- ✓ Property Tax Receipt
- ✓ Veteran's Universal I.D. Card
- ✓ Pilot's License
- ✓ Hunting/Fishing License
- ✓ Court Order/Adoption or Name Change
- ✓ Utility Bill
- ✓ Jail/Prison I.D. or Release Form
- ✓ Medicaid Card

We cannot accept:

Novelty I.D. Card (ski passes, club cards)
or
Driving Privilege Card

If you cannot provide acceptable identification, ask a spouse, parent, sibling or adult child who can provide appropriate I.D. Proof of relationship may also be required – such as birth, death or marriage certificates.
